My father came with his parents to Haileybury in 1889 and they homesteaded the first farm on the West Road there were ten in the family. My two uncles John and Thomas bought land and cleared it for farms and this is how it got the name (Fleming Corner). My father and uncle Leslie went with the fire rangers they worked mostly in Matheson area. Then my father started a store on Browning street and had this till 1914 sold to Graham Brochers now Davies grocery. He joined the army and was gone three years when he returned he went back to fire rangers. Was in Matheson the time of 1922 fire as there were bad fires there also. We were living on Browning St. down not far from tracks Norfolk and Rodchester had piles of lumber from the track to Graham's store. The station was on fire when we left. We went to Whorley's green house and from there to lake. In early hours of morning we came back to high school. The relief train took us to Huntsville to relatives the next day. He built a relief house on Main Street where he ran his store from 1923 to 1954. Prestons store where Steve is now. I can't remember as a little girl Santa always threw pennies in store at X-mas. I worked dress making from 1945-1947, also made slipcovers for Corby's. I received \$25. for chesterfield and two chairs.
