I worked on different farms in the area. Then was stable boy and lived here as I was on Call at all times for Dr. McNaughton had four horses I looked after and drove them to see their pataients also drove Dr. Farlinger Sr. and three other doctors. I quit here one month before Dr. McNaughton died I come to North Cobalt and worked for Thicke's bakery near busy corner till the 1922 fire.

We had a two wheel cart pulled by a horse of team with two barrels with hose filled sewer water was our fire wagon and it was all volunteer work.

In depression I went to work for Abe Clark on his farm in Lorraine Township also picked silver from dumps in Cobalt and Silver Centre. The only means of transportation at this time was horses or walk. I did quite a lot of boxing and football in my early days.
