#### 2. CEO REPORT FOR MARCH/APRIL 2025

- Our Easter Celebration went very well. The Easter Basket draw was won by Vivian Ward. We sold all 300 tickets which brought in \$518. We had 33 children in for the Easter Egg Hunt with 27 Adults attending. The 4 winners of the colouring contest were Sage Taylor, Lexa, Lily and Lauren. Everyone had a good time, and we sold some books at this event as well.
- ➤ I have applied for 4 grants. We did receive \$1400 from Plant Youth for Tabletop Role playing games. We will be starting with Dungeon and Dragons and Humblewood in May. We also received \$1500 from Legacy Grant to upgrade the patron computers. We did not receive the For Kids sake grant at this time I will reapply in September. I have not heard back for the Frogs Breath Grant yet. We also received permission to redirect the balance of the past Legacy Grant to help preserve the archives.
- ➤ Historical Society will be working with us in June to help us preserve or historical/archive section of the library.
- Latchford is working on the contract and funding to join us
- Our Print bill was way over this month due to the Colouring contest, Easter tickets and patron usage.
- ➤ Homework Buddy we have a group of 4 kids that come in and participate in learning things like depth perception, temperature etc.
- Lego Club for ages 6 to 9, open Lego Club we have about 4 kids that come regularly and a few drop-ins.
- > Tech, help we have only had a few people in for this expertise, but we do have more coming in for the use of computers.
- ➤ We have craft days, board game days and electronic game days. We are looking into trivia night social, book clubs.

We are working on making sure all the books are Cataloged properly for reporting.

The Children's section is completed and rearranging this section will begin soon.

We have located some of the covers for the lighting and still looking for more once

found the town will come and install them. No ETA yet.
